Interim Prime Minister Sushila Karki has expanded her cabinet, appointing three new ministers.

- Om Prakash Aryal Minister of Home Affairs, and Minister of Law & Parliamentary Affairs.
- Kulman Ghising Minister of Energy, Water Resources & Irrigation;
- Minister of Physical Infrastructure & Transport; Minister of Urban Development
- Dr. Rameshwore Khanal Minister of Finance
- Sabita Bhandari Attorney General

Key decisions from the newly-appointed ministers include:

- Ghising ordered the firms to pay Dedicated and Trunk line arrears.
- Aryal declared national mourning for those killed in the Gen-Z Movement and announced NPR 100,000 funeral support along with government transport of the deceased to their homes.

Supreme Court resumes partial operation: The Supreme Court has reopened under temporary arrangements, currently hearing habeas corpus cases and complaints of unlawful detention

Deceased protestors declared Martyrs: The death toll from Gen-Z protest has reached 72. Bereaved families will receive compensation of NPR 1 million and be declared Martyrs. Meanwhile, at least 2,113 people had sustained injuries and the Interim Government has announced free medical treatment for those involved in the protests.

Ousted parties' statement lacked remorse and accountability: Nepali Congress condemned attacks on its leaders Sher Bahadur Deuba and Arzu Deuba but ignored the large cash seizures, failed to mention Ramesh Lekhak's role as home minister, and did not address responsibility for the September 8 killings. Similarly, CPN-UML expressed condolences and framed the September 8 state brutality as a tragedy while shifting blame for the September 9 violence to "anarchic" forces, avoiding any acknowledgment of failures under then Prime Minister KP Oli.
